In-group Bias

“Now everybody from the 313, put your mother-f*cking hands up and follow me”.

Herd Behaviour

“put your hands up and follow me.”

Availability Cascade

“look, look.”

Distinction Bias

“Now while he stands tough, notice that this man did not have his hands up.”

Ambiguity Bias

“this man.”

Credential Bias

“one, two, three, and to the four.”

Availability Cascade (again)

“one Pac, two Pac, three Pac, four.”

Ingoup/Outgroup

“You’re Pac, He’s Pac,”

VS

“You’re Pac, NONE”

List the Objections First

“I know everything he’s got to say against me.”

“I am white”

“I am a fuckin bum”

“I do live in a trailer with my mom”

“My boy, Future, is an Uncle Tom”

“I do have a dumb friend named Cheddar Bob who shot himself with his own gun”.

“I did get jumped by all six of you chumps”

Sympathetic Connection

“And Wink did Fuck my Girl”

Heroic Association

“I’m still standing here screaming
“Fuck Tha Free World””

Humor Bias

**“But I know Something About You”
(smile)**

Outgroup

“You went to Cranbrook.”

“That’s a private school.”

“His real name’s Clarence. And his parents have a real good marriage.”

Credential bias

“There ain’t no such thing as...”

“Halfway Crooks!”

Scarcity

“F*ck everybody”

“F*ck y’all if you doubt me.”

“I don’t wanna win. I’m outtie.”
